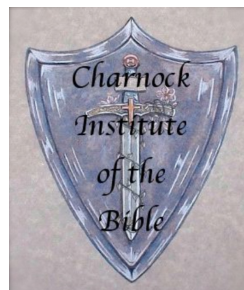

*“I’ve Never Heard
This Before!”*

The statement above has been heard around here so many time that we have stopped counting. CIB offers a curriculum that is unique in the true sense of the word (i.e. no one else is doing it!). Only at CIB . . .

- will students translate the entire Greek New Testament for themselves. Every word!
- will students translate the entire Hebrew Old Testament, including Aramaic sections, for themselves.
- will students learn to see Jesus Christ in every Old Testament passage. Often times Hebrew is required to set off Jesus from others in the passage “the RIGHTEOUS (ONE) verses the wicked.” Without the Hebrew informing one that the RIGHTEOUS is singular, and the wicked is plural, it is hidden. All through the Psalms the Hebrew displays this contrast.
- will students learn to see the glory of God in a pencil, a rock, paint, a road, etc. As well as learn where this entire creation

program is headed; and what the eternal state will be. I.e. “What’s the point!” Many speak of going to heaven as if that ends it all; as if there were no resurrection.

- will students read all the documents written by the early Church up to A.D. 325. These provide for: 1. All the systematic theology you will ever need. 2. All the Church History you will ever need from that era. 3. A clear view of which doctrines were considered of greatest importance. 4. Cultural studies of the Jews, Romans, Greeks, and others. 4. A complete of study of the Roman and Greek gods. Who they are, where they were born (yes born!), where they are buried, and their life styles (they were all perverts). A complete study of the attributes of God, of Jesus in the Old Testament passages, of studies of the end times (eschatology), of the virgin birth, dispensationalism, church leadership, church discipline, etc. etc. etc.
- will students learn to see “c o m m u n i c a t i o n” throughout the creation.

That someone is sending information; and that the sending of information implies a receiver who can read it. The ultimate information being communicated is the Bible.

We are not a Liberal-Arts College. We are a Theological Institute. Our curriculum leads students to conversations which only those having had such studies can have; and to conclusions which they will reach on their own.
