



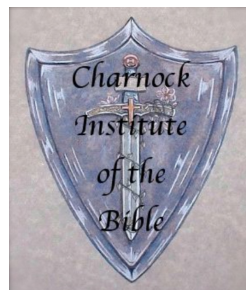
Real History Verses ???

CIB STAFF OPENINGS

We have several openings coming to CIB this Summer. We function as a missions ministry so please have this in mind before applying. Staff at CIB have unlimited access to courses at no charge (their spouses are allowed to take any class their husband/wife is taking). Included openings are:

CIB Registrar & Secretary - This person is the pivot of the operations. Interviewing, answering questions & helping with students in every way. He/She should understand basic internet technology and basic book keeping.

Professor of Biblical Languages and Theology - This person must be fluent (or close to it) in Greek and Hebrew, as courses are taught from these languages as a background. If applying, please be ready to sight-read your Greek and Hebrew Bible at the interview. Your Degree will not help you if you cannot read these languages comfortably. You will be required to take Biblical Aramaic and some Latin at CIB.

Missions, Ministry & Church History - This person will be responsible for organizing, instructing, and leading all those items described in the Title!

Charnock Institute of the Bible does not approach or teach the Bible as other Bible Colleges do. Students translating the entire Bible, require Professors who have done the same. Students reading all known Church History documents of the Ante-Nicene writings, need Professors who have done the same. Students need Professors who can give them what they cannot get for themselves. Not lecturing about what they can get from scores of other books by just reading them. The gold, silver and precious stones of the original texts, and the views of the early Church, are worth digging out, and are worth handing out.

Jesus the Messiah is seen throughout the Hebrew Bible but often lost in translation. Students need Professors who can give them their Lord shining in the text!
