Kenya will be our next project; where 25 full time students await Pastoral training. These are predominately Pastors who have not Theological training to speak of. They plan on beginning in January.

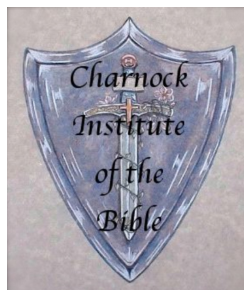

interact with the professors in intelligent ways since they have either translated the entire Old Testament or the entire New Testament. This combined with the O.T. and N.T. Introductions, Hermeneutics, Introductory courses in Church History, Missions, Thousands of pages of the first Early Church Writers, introductions to Worldviews, Biblical Counseling, the Attributes, Character and Eternal Plan of God, all combine to change the hearts and minds and lives of students. They will work with manuscripts in their final years, including: Esther scrolls from Warsaw, complete Torah Scroll from Morocco, Partial torahs from Russia, other pieces from other locations, Greek texts, Latin texts from antiquity, and more. These become the textbooks for advanced classes.

Our students have been Pastors, Missionaries, Bible Instructors, both locally and from abroad. No greater experience than when students come to conclusions which are actually instructing the Instructors. They are, or

have become, colleagues in the field of Theology.

Luther said that in every field of life we acknowledge there are masters; but when it comes to the Bible every man thinks himself a theologian. The answer, of course, to Luther's point, is to actually begin to master the Biblical text (as well as be mastered by it!).

Confusion in practice comes from confusion in doctrine. All streams of living water come from the higher lake of the land of the Trinity described in the Biblical Text itself. To cut the stream off from the source up stream, is to loose the stream of living water completely. The river of life flows from the throne of God and of the Lamb in Revelation 22. The point here is NO THRONE = NO RIVER OF LIFE!

The Biblical languages themselves have cleared up many problem or difficult passages for myself and others. Gaining an understanding of what a text does NOT say is often helpful in trying to obtain the actual meaning of the Biblical author. It takes more than a simple Concordance

or Bible Dictionary (as helpful as these are!) to get a feel for the original or actual text. The Eastern-Minded Old Testament has, in fact, to be Westernized to get it into English. Quite a chore! Lack of consistency between Old Testament translators and New Testament translators has historically confused readers; or at best left them without the Hebrew context for interpreting New Testament words or expressions. Time does not allow for a full explanation here. So consider joining us at CIB for the fuller and more complete picture. You will NEVER read your Bible the same again!
