



New Master's Degree

CIB is set to launch a new the entire Greek New Testament, at degree this summer. A Master's CIB. Degree in Ancient Jewish Bible Interpretation. The Degree will focus on a comparison of: 1. the complete Hebrew Bible. 2. the Greek translation made before the New Testament era called the Septuagint (also LXX=70). 3. the Targumim, or Aramaic translation and commentary of the Hebrew Bible. 4. the Peshitta, or first Jewish-Christian translation of the Hebrew Bible into Aramaic. The course of study will also include an anthology of early Rabbinic interpretation. This Degree is uniquely designed for those who have translated the entire Hebrew Old Testament (with Aramaic) and

This course is designed to master the various Jewish views of the Old Testament from roughly 200 B.C.E. to C.E. 200; with additional anthology of views to about C.E. 600. By comparing the Hebrew text (it is read in its entirety) with the first Jewish translation into Greek, known as the Septuagint, the first interpretations of the Old Testament come into view; they did alter the text to match their own views. Then the Targumim are read. These are the Aramaic translation of the Old Testament. They also have added right into the text their own Jewish views. There are three different Targums for the

Tanzania is now on the back burner. Please pray for clarity as we establish relationships with those in countries where Bible Training is not readily available.

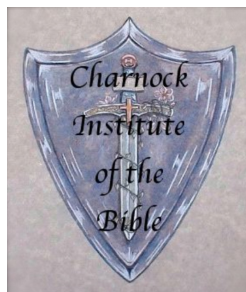

writings of Moses. Then most of the rest of the Old Testament was also translated. These not only provide their translator's view of the meaning of the text, but they add large amounts of commentary right into the text (as if it was part of the original). One of the chief values of the Targumim is when the word "Messiah" is added right into the text itself. When Messiah is called God in Isaiah 9:6 "He shall be called Wonder, Counselor, the mighty God, Father of Eternity, Messiah." So in Isaiah 52 the sprinkling the people with his blood, the Targum adds that this passage concerns the Messiah; note it is continued in Isaiah 53 where Messiah will be the Sin-Offering. The study then goes to the Peshitta, which is the first Jewish-Christian translation of the Old and New Testaments into the Aramaic for Christians. Then added are the Rabbinic Interpretations of later times.

The reality is that the early Jewish Interpretation differed greatly from the later Rabbinic Interpretations.

This new Degree at CIB is for those who hold at least a B.Div. from CIB. They will already have the Jewish-Christian Interpretation of the Old Testament as it is written in the New Testament; since all B.Div. graduates at CIB have translated the Greek New Testament.

This project for CIB graduates with B.Div. degrees will run one and a half to two years to complete. It is a unique degree and a unique opportunity.

For those of you looking for a Bible College or Seminary, why not consider looking at Charnock Institute of the Bible.
