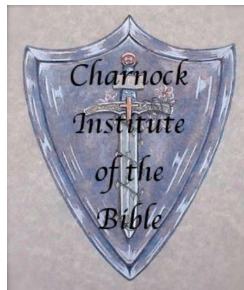

... to go to heaven. But in fact means “to be made whole.” “Salvation” seems to be the primary term in the New Testament for being made whole. Its illustrated in many of the healing which Jesus did and the term “healed” is actually the word for “salvation.” “Salve” is an ointment that heals. So sanctification is actually the becoming whole process. It is used of both believers and non-believers in the New Testament. **Justification** This is Romans. “God is Just and the Justifier.” Because of this justification by faith the Believer may now look forward to the Resurrection of the Righteous. **Disciples** Discipleship is on full display in the gospels. Jesus had His disciples and taught: 1. His Inner Circle: Peter, James, John and Andrew 2. His Twelve: These were actually being prepared for Apostolic Authority 3. The Seventy: These were evidently put together for a Seminar-Outreach 4. Crowd(s): These are simply the multitudes mixed with believers and non-believers 5. Others: There were others that Jesus interacted with that we are told nothing about: The upper room owner, the donkey owner, those the disciples said “cast out demons but not like us” and Jesus said “they are with us,” etc. **Making Disciples** Jesus said anyone who “continues in My word” is my true disciple.” This will include the hearing of the seeds of the gospel, thinking about them, responding to the Lord in a plea of mercy and repentance, actually learning and putting into practice the teachings, maturing to and through doing the Scriptures in a long term context, etc. When a person is converted is not always clear. and of itself will produce growth even as a baby grows from milk only for a season. Milk only will eventually harm the child. **Meat** “Belongs to those WHO BY REASON OF USE, have their senses EXERCISED to DISCERN both good and evil.” New Christians know something about good and evil but not a lot. Use, Exercised, Discerning, describes an adult. **Warfare** is not the flesh alone; rather it is: World This deals with any and all Ideologies and Philosophies of any age, nation, culture, family, context, etc. These corruptions are dealt with only by the Truth of God’s Word being lived out. These truths will bring a person into direct conflict with these Worldly Views as he comes to know and discern from a Biblical World View. Flesh The Hebrew words “flesh” and “lust” are the same word. Hence “lost of the flesh” is used in the New Testament so that the original meanings of the Old Testament are not lost. “In by flesh dwells no good thing,” is actually “In my fleshly-desires dwells no good thing.” Or even, “worldly-fleshy-desires” etc. **Devil** The word Devil means “slander” or even “to argue two positions.” “Di” means “two.” “Bolos” means to cast.” So Diabolos means to throw in two directions. Here we are dealing with a Spirit. Spirit in s scripture is used of the mind, thoughts, attitudes, posture, etc. Ezekiel says, “I know the thoughts that come into your spirit.” It is double-minded, slanderous of the right, harmful thoughts, darts thrown into the mind, etc. The Scriptures teach on all aspects of our lives (spirit, soul, body) but not at all times. Learning the mind of God from Genesis to Revelation, God will introduce a subject and over time

come back to it many times. Each time it has the potential of producing greater clarity. Eventually these truths begin to come more and more into focus, we begin to understand with greater clarity, sin becomes even more sinful, what Jesus has done becomes deeper than we can fathom, righteousness becomes an all consuming hope in Him. This is why Jesus said, “If you continue/remain in My Word, then are you my real disciples and you shall know the truth and the truth will set you free . . . if the Son of Man (Messiah) shall set you free you shall be free indeed!”
