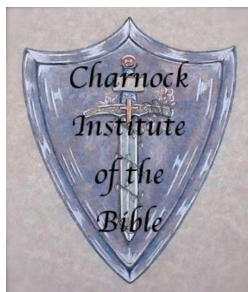

Is Justification Salvation?

Seeing our word for SALVATION in its true context of simply making people whole helps us understand what God is offering us . . . the opportunity to become whole in our Spirit (mind), Soul (passions), and body (in the resurrection). In Matthew 1, "You shall call His name JESUS for He shall SAVE His people from their sins." So forgiveness is definitely a part, but the SALVATION demonstrated through Matthew was actually in their healing. In Leviticus disease regularly is called sin. It is the visible manifestation that sin has taken its toll. Jesus displayed the Salvation which would be a sign to them that He can also deal with the original cause. The name Jesus is the Hebrew JOSHUA. The root is SHUA meaning "to call" for help. Paul plays off of this when in Romans 10 he says, "whosoever shall CALL on the name of the Lord shall be Saved;" and this is the meaning of Joshua and so the meaning of Jesus. But it is to be saved from anything, and not just sins. This is very clear with a simply browsing of a Greek Concordance; as well as how the early Church used the word.

At CIB when students see this for themselves, as they translate the entire Greek New Testament for themselves, it is life changing. God does not simply want to Justify them, or

make them Righteous with the Righteousness of the Son of God, but He wants to make them healthy and whole. What an offer! "Do you want to be made whole?" - Jesus
