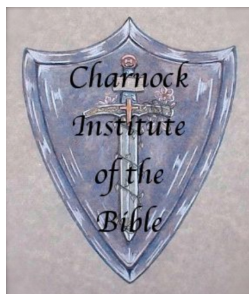

- Hebrew Grammar & Reading



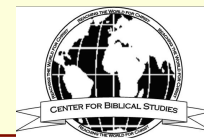
- Discipleship I and II

### Summer Session

Greek Grammar and Reading begins on June 6th. We have added the words “and Reading” because large amounts of the Greek New Testament are read in class. By the time the student has finished the 10 week course, they will have read through many chapters (in some cases all) of individual books. For example Romans and Revelation, or John, or some Epistles. “Its the reading that did it!” is a phrase that we have heard again and again. Seeing real Greek, mile after mile, new vocabulary introduced and old vocabulary used in context. Syntax, word studies, grammar studies all over the New Testament, etc. make for a fuller program. The same is true of Hebrew. I normally read and teach through the first 25 chapters of Genesis with the students; as well as Ruth and Jonah. It is an eye opener to them.

The real Bible, if I may call it so, moves them in a way that no translation can.

CIB’s approach is unique and certainly not for everyone.
