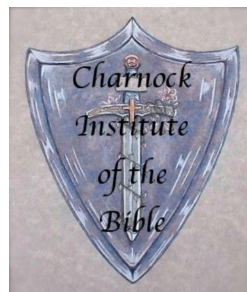

the College. These manuals explain exactly where to begin. Next all of the Textbooks, Workbooks, Answer Keys, etc. are put in order.

Now the fun begins! Students must register. At the first Class they receive all Textbooks and a Workbook with includes the Syllabus with Assignments for that course. As they complete some classes they bring books back and receive the books for the next section.

Each New Bible College sets the dates for their Semesters. They are provided with several grading systems from which to use or design their own. There are NO CORRESPONDENCE COURSES! Though classes may operate with the texts alone and the Proctor administrating the tests, it is suggested that Discussions take place at the very least over the materials. Experienced Pastors and/or Professors may add lectures.

Another important item in the College In A Box Program is ministry. Each student is expected to serve 5 - 10 hours each week. Jesus Disciples by having His students serve others.

Finally, students are told not to write in the books or workbooks themselves in order that they may be in good shape to be passed on to the next students coming into the program. This keeps costs down considerably!

Each set of texts should last the College for years to come.

These Colleges are owned and operated by Men who are born, raised and live in these communities. They Must Do It! Our names will not be known! The men and women in their communities must see these Colleges as belonging to the Communities of Christians running them.
