. . . is an Aramaic Translation with Commentary Inserted into the text (perhaps the first Study-Bible). TARGUM is the Aramaic word for TRANSLATION. The entire Old Testament was Targumized. Some of these Targums have been found among the Dead Sea Scrolls. others date to A.D. 200, and still others perhaps later. They provide unique Translation and Interpretation of Jewish Scholars; even before the Talmud!

4. Vulgate - This is Jerome's Translation of thew Greek and Hebrew Texts into the Common (Vulgar) Language. It became the Bible of the Church until the Reformation.w

All of these together will provide a Commentary from the earliest days. Much of the Church today is steeped in new and perverted Interpretations which were in face Unknown to the Jews or Christians of history. Like Paul wrote to the Corinthians, "How is it that everyone has interpretation?" (1 Cor. 14). He then continued to tell them that such craziness simply has to stop!

If you are fluent in the languages that will be used in this upcoming Translation, then we welcome your input and assistance. Just remember that all interpretations must yield to the Greek and Hebrew Bible!

I have begun with a Sample Translation with Notes and sent it out to a handful of Scholars and Laymen to look at. They are in fact excited about the project.

Time Frame: This Project will be available in pieces. The Project is simply too large to happen overnight. It will proceed as we have time and resources!
