



Discipleship & Bible Mastery

There is little clarity out there on what exactly is needed in a Discipleship Program for Churches. Specifically the HOW? and ultimately THE GOAL! Paul said that the goal of ministry is "to present every person MATURE in Christ" (Col 1:28). So, where is the Discipleship Program that will bring a person to maturity?

Several things should be noted clearly.

1. Discipleship is not a 10 week course. True Christian Maturity cannot be put on a Calendar. People mature at different rates of time.
2. Discipleship is not to go on forever. "By now you should be teachers," Hebrews says. Maturity is Graduation!
3. Maturity is not a class in a building. No Text Book can do this. People must Serve!

4. Clarity to know what our part is & what is ONLY between Jesus Himself and the Heart of a man or a woman. There are limitations to what we can do! Soft Hearts = Teachable.

This now brings us to the crux of the matter. What can a Church do that will work in any Culture, Country, or Financial Context? I want to suggest that we simplify EVERYTHING.

1. Mastery of Scripture. This should go without saying. Repentance is ALWAYS turning to the Teachings of the Scriptures. The Scriptures are the Milk; Living It Is The Meat!
2. Serving was a great part of Jesus' Program for the Disciples. Running Errands, Serving Bread, Washing Feet was all a part of learning how to be a Church Leader . . .

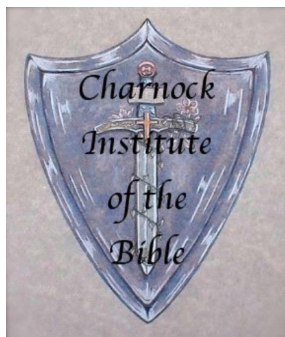

3. Several Years should do it IF YOU HAVE BACKGROUND! When Jesus began to instruct the 12, He did not have to teach them the names of the books of the Bible, or who Elijah or Moses were.
