

. . . for Mongolia. We are completing the first year of courses in what will form the Pastoral Training Program for the MONGOLIA NOMADIC BIBLE INSTITUTE in Mongolia. All Curriculum is in their native language (their heart language in which they think, and in which they sin).

Most of the curriculum which has been developed for the Mongolian Nomadic Bible Institute is new. No there College or Seminary has used it before. Its uniqueness lies in it Inductive Based Approach. Students are placed in a context in which they are learning to learn. In this lies the Inductiveness, or drawing the truth out of the text for one's self. In fact, it appears that this may even be something that we at CIB want to look into adopting.

In nine months time each student will read through the New Testament 10 to 12 times. This is besides the regular reading required in their New Testament Survey class! They will memorize the book of Colossians in the first Semester. Memorizing Scripture is a major part of the curriculum.

The Interpretation Class is Inductive and requires them to dig and dig some more. To think and draw their own conclusion on what the text says. They will study through entire books of Scripture and draw their conclusion as to what the author meant. They will determine for themselves

what the Scriptures teach in handling ongoing sin in a Church, or even a sinning Pastor. How to interpret Psalms, Proverbs, New and Old Testament Books and the rest.

The Shepherding Introduction Class will require an Inductive and in-depth study of the Pastoral letters. This is 1, 2 Timothy and Titus; along with in depth readings of Acts focusing on Biblical Leadership. They will see for themselves what Shepherding is and is not.

Students are in active ministry 5 to 10 hours each week for the entire time of their education. The Bible knows nothing of Learning Without Serving. Washing feet and serving was a major part of walking with Jesus and being discipled by Him; and by the Apostles as well.

Mongolia has been a unique challenge and the Church has only gotten into the country since the 1990s. God has brought them along very well and there is much to do. If it is His will, we pray that this curriculum will be:

- 1. Affordable The costs of all books and materials for a full year training is less than \$100 per student.
- 2. Available Much of what has been developed is being made available online to download for free.
- 3. Usable Any Church can start a Learning Center.
- Practical The materials are designed to train Pastors first and foremost.

The future is bright for White Stone Missions. God has shocked us all in the great missions opportunities He has brought into our world. We look to Him for all His plans for us.
