How Many Missions Organizations are out there is unknown. Some have a distinct focus like Bible Translation, or a Specific Group like Muslims, or Tribes, and others do everything. There certainly is a place for most of it. **White Stone**

missions was originally formed to plant Bible Colleges of genuine quality on Mission Fields, without all of the normal costs involved. Pennies on the \$1 was and is the intent. Local Staff and Reusable Materials would maintain a quality curriculum without the great costs normally involved.

We are now turning a corner. The White Stone Missions Board, while involved in many different projects and with different Missions Organizations, are focussing, or shall I say refocussing, our Bible College Approach. From the beginning we realized that unless we can put in place Mature Pastors and Bible Teachers, the Church would remain carnal and immature in that area. So we are designing and retooling our

original approach, to create THE BIBLE MASTERY DISCIPLESHIP PROGRAM. This program is in 4 parts and can be translated into any language on earth for very little cost.

PART 1 NEW BELIEVERS

When men and women call on Jesus Christ and become new creations, their first need is those books of the New Testament which are written to New Christians. It is where the Apostles began with New Christians and where we should also begin. These books can be covered in about 10 Weeks time and will help them get their bearings. The New Christians Discipleship begins with:

The Gospel of John, 1, 2, 3 John, Galatians, 1, 2 Peter. 1, 2 Thessalonians. These are the texts which are written to New Christians.

PART 2 MATURING BELIEVERS

Once the essentials are mastered, maturing Christians need to move to an organized approach to reading

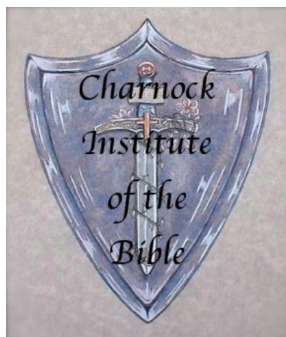

the Bible. This is simply learning how to read the New Testament for Mastery, and having a basic guide to allow them to make sense of how the Old Testament fits together. For example, if the gospel of Mark is broken into three sections,

1. Mark 1-5
2. Mark 6-10
3. Mark 11-16

Part 1 is read daily for 30 days, then part 2 daily for 30 days, and then part 3 for 30 days. The advantage of this is that they will actually know their way around the gospel of Mark, and have a feel for where things are. In 3 years they will have read the New Testament through 30 times. If they do only 15 day readings it will take them a year and a half.

PART 3 CHURCH LEADERS
Church Leaders are chosen from those who are mature. Their focus is on the ministries of the Church and seeing to it that “the goal of our ministry is to present every man mature in Christ” (Colossians 1). They will need to do whatever works best in their own country and culture to accomplish this. For example, if the people cannot read, they must design a public Bible reading program to teach their people. The Church Leaders should begin with a Leadership Training Program which takes them through a detailed study of the the Pastoral Epistles; 1, 2

Timothy and Titus, along with a detailed reading of the book of Acts while focussing on Church leadership, appointment of leaders, how they planted Churches, made decisions, how they handled sin, etc.

PART 4 PASTORS

Here is where a person(s) is selected to get more Biblical training in order to benefit the Church and communicate the Scriptures with clarity. The word SHEPHERD, in Hebrew is literally a “FEEDER.” Shepherds feed sheep, lead them to water, and fight with wolves, lions and bears. These are men of the Word, who can deal with false teachers and false teachings. They can and must handle the Living Scriptures in such a way that brings the Church to maturity.

PART 4, as you can guess, is more involved. What of the tribes which have only a New Testament and no access to attend a Bible College? This curriculum is Inductive, and fully Self-Contained. It is a Pastoral-Training Curriculum, with Basic Hermeneutics, Basic Theology, Basic Ministry, Shepherding and Ministry Principles, and Intensive Bible Reading for Mastery, as its core. Don't assume the curriculum will be compromised instead of maintaining a quality which will stand up against anything offered at any other Quality Bible College. The goal is to provide them with the best

Biblical Training Materials for their context.

THE COST? Pennies on the \$1. The curriculum will be kept to the NEEDED ESSENTIALS to avoid publishing materials which really are not needed. Once complete, the only real cost is Translation. Once this is finished, materials will be placed on a web-site where they can be accessed and downloaded by anyone in their language. This means that each language group will have up-front costs only.

Parts 1, 2 and 3 are completed and their translation into other languages has begun. Part 4 is presently being written and translated into select languages.
