Ministry opportunities at White Stone Missions include:

1. Get training for Wycliffe Associates. This is required for all those headed to work with them on Translation Projects. These are actually helping others understand the English! No languages required. Then you are qualified to go to many Translation Projects around the world.
2. Projects presently that we are working on include:
 - a. Work through some assignments in Biblical Studies for the New Pastor Training Institute in Mongolia. We are checking materials for quality and workload.
 - b. Possible Publishing work in the month of March.
3. We have a possible major Missions Web Site to be developed. We need Translation work for Every Language; not large items, but Translation that can be completed in a day.
4. Mission's Banquet is once a year (Come!), and Missions Yard Sale this

year is twice in the month of April. There is always room for help.

5. Go on a Mission: If this is in your heart then there are a couple of things to do now or you may miss an opportunity when it comes.

a. Get Passports - These take a bit of time but if the right opportunity comes along and a Missions Team says we have need of a couple of people and all the expenses are covered, you might not have time to get a passport.

b. The Wycliffe Training - There are times when Wycliffe Associates needs one or two people. Is your Church Missions Minded? If so they can perhaps raise the monies for the trip. Wycliffe typically give several weeks advance notice of where they need someone.

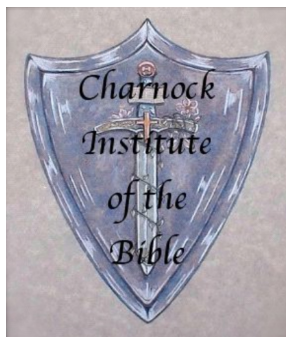


PLAN NOW FOR THIS COMING SUMMER

a Global Discipleship Program. It will be simple and effective for anyone who will complete the Program. It will be in many languages and provided free of charge to anyone in any location who can get online with a phone, computer, or even print it off. There are 3 Steps which can be provided in any language where Translators can be located. There are 4 Steps for the others.

Step #1 NEW CHRISTIANS

A New Christians Discipleship Program. They read each section DAILY for a week

Week 1 John 1-5
 Week 2 John 6-10
 Week 3 John 11-15
 Week 4 John 16-21

Underline each thing Jesus tells you to do or not do.

Week 5 1, 2, 3 John
 Count or Underline the word KNOW in 1st, 2nd, 3rd John. Note WHAT you can or need to KNOW and HOW.

Week 6 1 Peter
 Underline each COMMAND.

Week 7 2 Peter
 WHAT are the WARNINGS that Peter is dealing with and WHAT are you to do?

Week 8 1 Thessalonians
 Underline each COMMAND.

Week 9 2 Thessalonians
 What are they (or You) told to do?

Week 10 Galatians

What is the LAW for? How do you get out of its condemning? Are there any Commands or Warnings? Name them.

Step #2 Maturing CHRISTIANS

After Step 1, they continue on through the rest of the New Testament reading each designated section daily for 30 days, or for 15 days. There is a guide to Reading the Old Testament correctly.

Step #3 Church Leaders

This is for those who have been through their Bibles. They go back through the books of the Bible that deal with Church Leaders: the Pastoral Epistles, 1 and 2 Timothy, Titus. There is more but these are studied intensely.

(THERE WILL BE 2 PATHS AVAILABLE WHEN POSSIBLE)

Step #4 PASTORAL TRAINING

This is for those who will need training in Pastoral Studies. One Year of College Level Studies and Ministry will be provided.

Through this entire process Jesus Himself, who is alive in His people, will accomplish the rest. His Spirit in them to mature them in simple obedience.

These tools are already being offered and used. They work!

We will begin soon putting these on a page at White Stone Missions where the program will be hosted.
