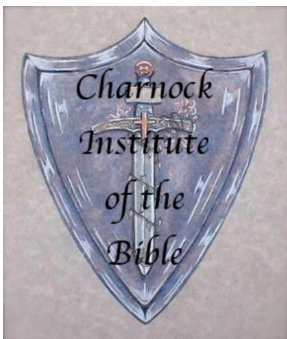

Still, they pressed on knowing that death was a reality in an era or new age of Biblical light.

The other item, beside the Greek and Hebrew, was the Early Church Fathers. What exactly did the Early Church Believe and Teach? They found that the the Early Church Writers were misquoted, and believed a lot differently than the priest were teaching. Especially in an age when most of the Priests could not read!

The Early Church Fathers are filled with clarity on the Attributes of God, on the Gospel, on Church Leadership, on Conducting Church Services, on Dealing with Sin in the Church, on the Last Days, and much, much more! Clarity, Clarity, and More Clarity!

The Roman Catholic Church reacted with banishment, murder, inquisitions, lying, coverups, and more. The ungodliness of the Priests and Popes were notorious. The corruptions were everywhere and so the new movement needed no further witnesses besides what everyone already knew.

The Catholic Priest and Scholar Erasmus was writing about the abuses of children that were EVERYWHERE in the Catholic world. In his priestly upbringing he could be drunk or immoral and that would be fine, but if he got caught with a book he would be beaten. His letter, which we read at CIB, paint the reality of a

Roman Church full of smut, child abuse, ignorance and more. Erasmus lived and died a Roman Catholic and yet described Roman Catholicism just as the Reformers did. The Reformation was a movement of education, a return to the gospel as preached in the Bible and the Early Church, a movement of Bibles in the languages of the people so that the people could read Scriptures for themselves and respond to the teachings in it.

At CIB we major on these very items that the Reformers did. We do not tell you, rather we give you the Bible in Greek, Hebrew, Aramaic, and the Early Church Writings in their entirety up to a.d. 325 (a 3 year journey!). We then spend a year reading the writings of the Major Reformers. See for yourself what the Bible says in its original form, and what the Church taught during and from the time of the Apostles for the first few hundred years. No Hearsay! Hearsay Theology is for the ignorant men of the Dark-Ages.

Jesus has come to give the light of Himself to those who have sat in darkness. There is nothing greater than Him and His Teachings which set men and women free from ignorance, slavery, sin and abuse. There is always a false gospel out there masquerading as the truth of a Jesus unknown to Bible, the Apostles, the Early Church, the Greek and Hebrew. A

false Jesus who enslaves men and women and lies to them.
